Contract Personnel Announced

Gallup, NM – The contract personnel for the 2021 RAM Turquoise Circuit Finals Rodeo, presented by Bucky's, were announced Friday by the Turquoise Circuit Board of Directors.

Reed Flake will be on the microphone for the three performance event in Camp Verde, AZ Nov. 5 & 6. Flake, who has previously announced the event, calls Snowflake, AZ home.

Mikey Jo Duggan is the TCFR secretary; this is the first time Duggan will be Secretary for the Turquoise Circuit Finals. Timers will be Mary Borgen and Lill Worthen, who are both veterans of the annual event.

Tel Honeycutt and Tanner Resor will be working as Pickup Men assisting our cowboys and stock contractors.

Nate Reed of Buckeye, AZ, will be working the barrel as the 2021 barrel man. Reed has been entertaining from the barrel for over 15 years. Cowboy protectors Luke Kraut of Wittmann, AZ, and AJ Lutz from Phoenix, AZ, will serve as bullfighters.

During an action-packed weekend, the Turquoise Circuit Finals brings in the top 100 rodeo athletes from Arizona and New Mexico into the Camp Verde region, competing for approximately \$175,000 in prize money.

Circuit cowboys are known as 'weekend warriors,' competing at about 20 rodeos across Arizona and New Mexico in the hope of earning a qualification spot at the TCFR and for the opportunity to vie for a chance to qualify into the RAM National Circuit Finals Rodeo. The TCFR is part of the circuit system of the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association. The event will feature world champions, 'weekend warriors,' along with up-and-coming athletes looking to win a spot to compete at the RAM National Circuit Finals Rodeo.

Every performance will include bareback riding, steer wrestling, team roping, saddle bronc riding, tie-down roping, breakaway roping, barrel racing, and bull riding.

General admission and premium seats are available for all three rodeo performances. Tickets are available, and prices start at just \$15 (additional fees may apply).
