The TCFR is part of the circuit system of the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association. The event will feature world champions, 'weekend warriors,' along with up-and-coming athletes looking to win a spot to compete at the RAM National Circuit Finals Rodeo. Every performance will include bareback riding, steer wrestling, team roping, saddle bronc riding, tie-down roping, breakaway roping, barrel racing, and bull riding.
